

Q2: If you fly due West from London, where would you make landfall?

Answer C: New Foundland, Canada

If you kept flying the first USA state you would reach is Alaska (The Aleutian Islands).

New York is due west of Portugal and Washington is roughly on the same latitude as Madrid.

Q3: Which is the largest country in Africa by area?

A: Algeria B: Democratic Republic of the Congo C: Libya D: South Africa

Answer A: Algeria

- 1. Algeria (2.382m sq. Kilometres)
- 2. DR Congo (2.345m sq. kilometres)
- 3. Libya (1.760m sq. kilometres)

South Africa is 8^{th} (1.220m sq. Kilometres).

Q4: After Kinshasa in DR Congo, which is the largest city in Africa by population?

A: Cairo, Egypt B: Johannesburg, S Africa C: Lagos, Nigeria

Answer C: Lagos, Nigeria

- 1. Kinshasa (16.3m)
- 2. Lagos (15.3m)
- 3. Cairo (10.1m)

Johannesburg is 8^{th} with 6.1m).

Q5: The mainland of which country crosses the most time zones?

A: China B: Russia C: USA

Answer:

Russia with 11.

If you include overseas territories, France would have the most time zones with 12 (13 including its claim in Antarctica). Using this method and discounting Antarctica, Russia would be tied second with USA on 11, and Australia tied fourth with the UK on 9.

Q6: Which country has the most islands*?

A: Canada B: Finland C: Indonesia D: Norway E: Sweden

(* Landmasses permanently above water)

Answer E: Sweden

- 1. Sweden (267,570)
- 2. Norway (239,057)
- 3. Finland (178,947)
- 4. Canada (52,455).

Indonesia is 6th (after USA) with 17,504.

Q7: The Equator passes through 13 countries including Ecuador, Colombia, Brazil, Sao Tome & Principe, Gabon, Republic of the Congo, Democratic Republic of the Congo, Kenya, Somalia, Indonesia and Kiribati. Which one of the following does the Equator **NOT** pass through?

Answer C: 2

There are only two double landlocked countries in the world: Liechtenstein and Uzbekistan.

Answer B: Devon

Between Sidmouth and Beer.

Q10: If you fly due North from London, which is the first country you come to?

A: Greenland (Denmark)

B: Iceland

C: Russia

D: Svalbard (Norway)

Answer C: Russia

Greenland and Iceland are too far West and Svalbard too far East.

The most westerly point of Alaska is the Tip of Amatignak Island, Aleutian Chain, 179° 06′ 31″W whilst the most easterly point of Russia is the Diomede Islands 169°01′W.
