
# **BSCC Highway Code Quiz**




- If you have a moped or motorcycle licence you must pass a car theory test before taking the car driving test
- The theory test is made up of two parts taken at the same time multiple choice and hazard perception:
  - the multiple-choice (from 4 possible answers) is 50 questions in 57 minutes and you need to get at least 43 correct to pass
  - the hazard perception has 14 videos, each about a minute long and you must score 44 out of a possible 75 marks to pass
  - You must pass both parts of the test to get a test certificate
- This quiz is loosely based on the multiple-choice section but has five possible answers instead of four and mainly requires you to identify some of the more obscure road signs and markings
- There are 20 questions in this quiz
- Pass mark is 17 or more
