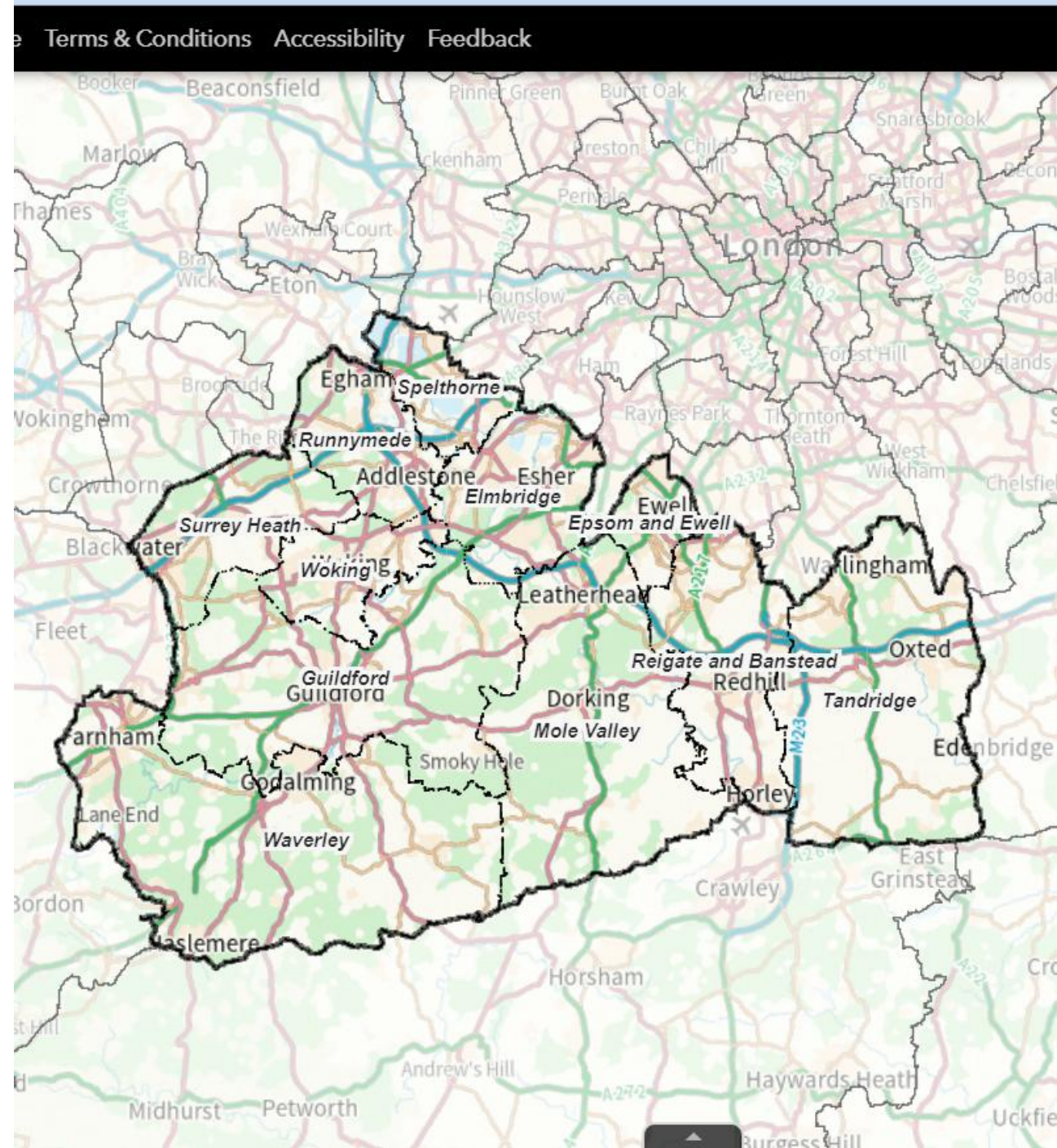

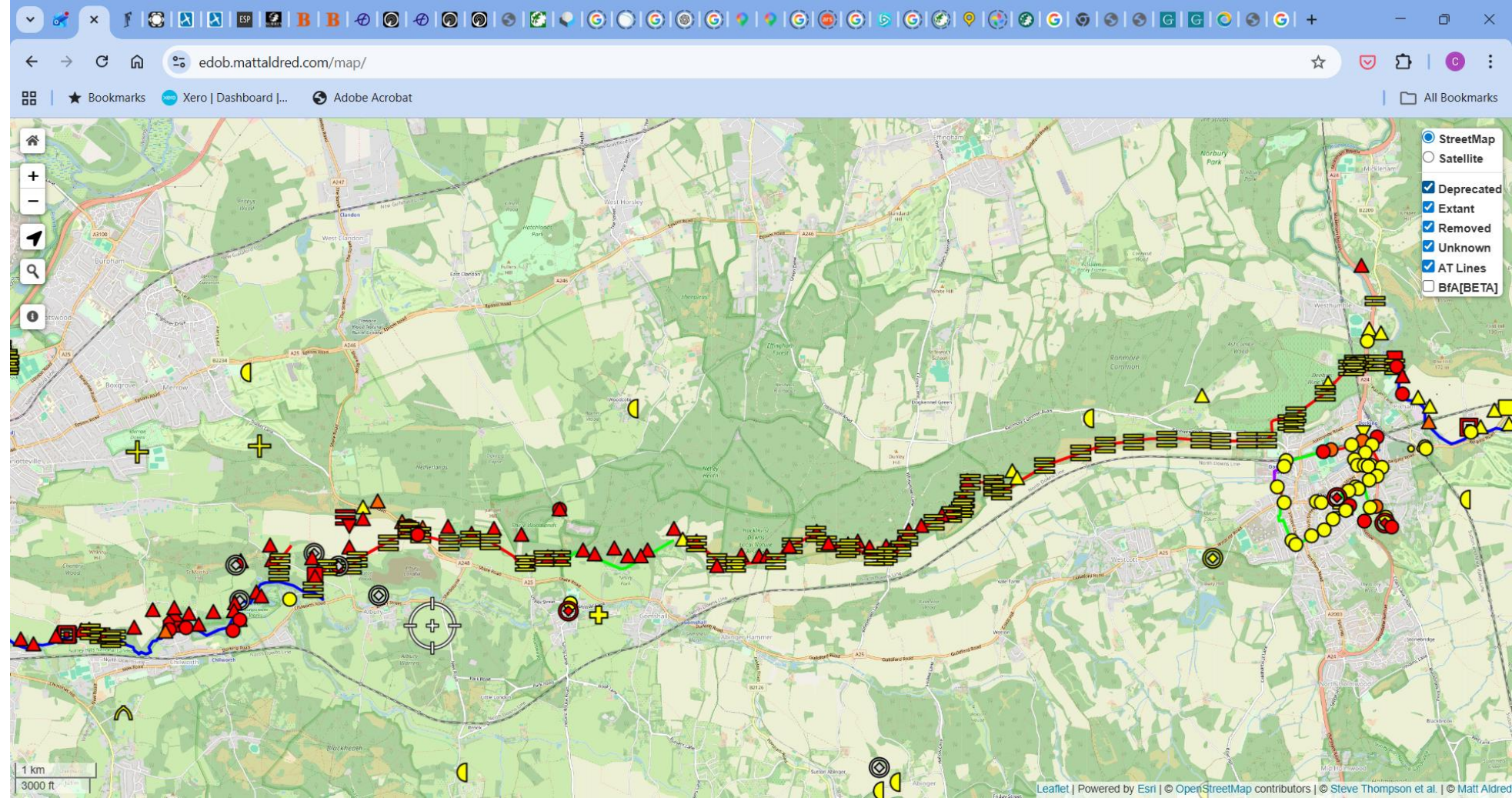


Key to Symbols:

AA = Anti-Aircraft Shell

As can be imagined, a huge number of shells were fired at enemy aircraft and these were designed to explode at a set height if they did not hit an aircraft first. The vast number of shells that were fired inevitably, some came back down. The result was either damage to property or a relatively small entry hole in the ground. Some shells exploded on contact with the ground. Suspected unexploded AA shells were not given priority as they were unlikely to be of immediate concern. Some "holes in the ground" for UX AA shells turned out to be caused by other items such as something heavy thrown into the air by a nearby bomb explosion or something fallen from a damaged aircraft. NOTE: Not all boroughs recorded AA shells, or identified them as shells (usually recording them as HE bombs).



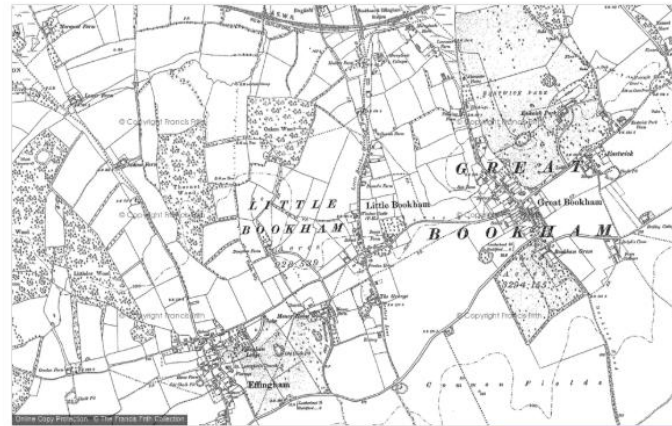

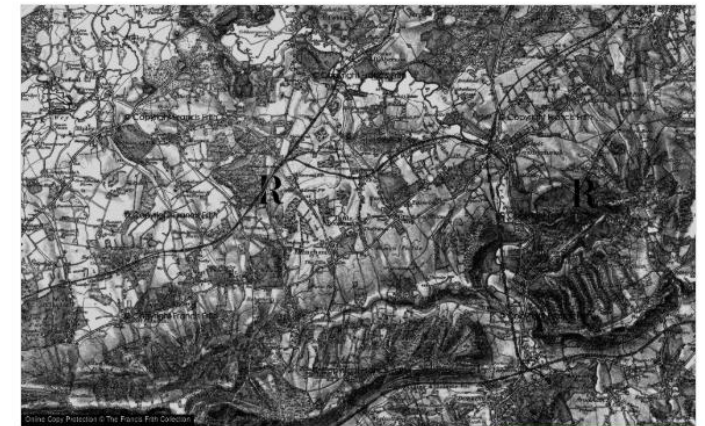
